WHAT IS AN INDEPENDENT VISITOR?

A volunteer who visits, advises and becomes a friend to a child or young person in care.

WHAT HAPPENS ON A VISIT?

Anything that you both enjoy i.e. picnics, movies, museums, pottery painting, walking, bowling...

WHO NEEDS AN INDEPENDENT VISITOR?

Children aged between 6-17 who do not have regular contact with a family member or who would benefit from having a regular visitor.
