Job Title: Music Graduate Accountable to: Music Teacher Grade: Scale 1D

CONTEXT

The postholder will be assisting within the music department providing a wide range of interventions from 1 to 1 to small group activities.

They will also assistant the music teacher within music lessons and within extra-curricular music activities.

The postholder will also play a key role in safeguarding students during 1 to 1 peripatetic lesson.

Classroom Duties

- Maintaining the classroom environment in a safe and orderly way; ensuring that the music room is able to function effectively at all times.
- Support students within class-based lessons
- Support with preparation and making of resources
- Ensuring instruments are cleaned and ready for use.
- Monitoring and maintaining instruments reporting any damage to the music teacher.
- Supporting students with accreditation courses as required.

Extra-curricular Activities

- Provide support in choir rehearsals and performances as required
- Provide support in lunch clubs and lead these sessions if required
- Providing one to one support for higher ability musicians as required.

Peripatetic lessons

- Prepare rooms for use by visiting teacher
- Sit within these lessons providing medical and behavioural support to the students
- Provide support to the visiting teacher within these lesson as required.

Other Duties

- Provide support to students at lunchtime as required
- Maintain records of instrument loans to classes
- Undertake any other duties commensurate with the post and grade that may be required of them by the Music teacher or any member of the management team
