- 3. Attend training sessions and toolbox talks as part of your development.
- 4. Complete all painting and decorating tasks to a high standard, ensuring clean, safe, and visually appealing finishes.
- 5. Support the collection and delivery of materials, tools, and equipment as required.
- 6. Accurately complete timesheets and other administrative tasks in line with council procedures.
- 7. Adhere to health and safety regulations and guidelines at all times.
- 8. Attend the nominated college and successfully complete the 24-month Painting and Decorating Level 2 Apprenticeship.
- 9. Carry out other non-decorating related tasks as required to support the wider building maintenance team.


Generic Duties and Responsibilities
