Skills and Abilities	<ul> <li>The ability to communicate effectively -both verbally and in writing, with Students, Parent/Carers, Governors, Local Authority (LA) and the wider community</li> <li>To adopt a flexible approach to the delivery of interventions as they relate to the curriculum</li> <li>The ability to respond calmly and constructively when dealing with students with SEND</li> <li>The ability to seek advice and assistance to meet students' needs</li> <li>To react calmly and quickly in an emergency team</li> <li>Ability to instruct and support teaching teams in a range of techniques to support learners within the class environment and in the use of specialised equipment</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>The ability to learn and use a range of strategies to deal with group and individual behaviours</li> </ul>

General and Specific Knowledge	<ul> <li>To have the ability to establish, develop and maintain procedures in relation to assessments required in a SEND environment</li> <li>Well established knowledge of therapeutic interventions relevant to the client group, especially an understanding of sensory integration strategies</li> <li>An understanding of and commitment to equality of opportunity in day-to-day working practices</li> <li>To demonstrate the ability to work as part of a team</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>To have an understanding of a wide range of SEND (including practices and procedures)</li> </ul>
Safeguarding	<ul> <li>To demonstrate a commitment to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children, young people and vulnerable adults</li> <li>Be willing to familiarise yourself with school policies and procedures in relation to Occupational Therapy, Safeguarding and Child Protection</li> </ul>
